

What you need to know as students return to school

### **General**

- With the exception of Year 12, the primary learning for all other year groups during this phase is still remote.
- Students are to wear full school uniform.
- The canteen will be open to buy food and drinks.

### **Organisation**

- Year 12 will be back fulltime and following their normal timetables.
- For Junior years, we have timetabled 1 period of English, Maths, Science, HSIE and PD/H/PE for the day
- Year 11 are scheduled across the 4 days.

### **Physical Distancing and Health Protocols**

- Please ensure your child is aware and understands physical distancing and health protocols.
- There is hand sanitiser in each room.
- There are posters throughout the school reinforcing the physical distancing and health protocols message.
- In key areas we have replicated procedures they have in some retail outlets with markings.
- In classrooms, we will be able to adhere to the guidelines of maximum numbers per room to ensure appropriate physical distancing can be implemented.
- There is enhanced cleaning of the school daily, with appropriate commercial cleaning products.
- Some staggered times during the day and end of day.

### **What to bring**

- It is recommended that students in Years 11 and 12 bring in their own devices and chargers. Mobile phones are not an acceptable device for learning.
- Headphones to engage in class activities.
- A refillable water bottle
- Although we do have sanitisers, it is recommended that students bring their own hand sanitiser and/or bacterial wipes.
- Exercise books and writing equipment.
