Library Opening Hours

The Library will be open before school, recess and lunch Monday to Friday.

2020 Premiers Reading Challenge

Important updates:

There have been some updates to the 2020 challenge rules to help all students complete the challenge this year. Key changes are:

- All students will be able to include 10 choice books on their student reading records. Previously only 5 choice books could be recorded.
- All students will be able to include books read as part of collaborative reading with teachers or parents/caregivers, either in person or on-line.
- Students who do not complete the Challenge in 2020 will not be disadvantaged from achieving cumulative PRC awards in the future.
